Honoring Beautification


RED CARPET WAS ROLLED OUT for honorees and those involved in preserving, beautifying, and designing a more beautiful Santa Barbara at the 44th annual Santa Barbara Beautiful Awards presentation at the Granada Theatre on September 28th.

Five special awards and nine property awards were part of the evening that began with a pre-awards reception featuring energized jazz by Les Gendarmes du Swing and tasty delights by Mondial. After reveling in the beauty



at the Granada, the crowd adjourned to the theatre itself.

The awards presentation began with a montage highlighting Santa Barbara Beautiful's (SBB) vear round activities in the community, as well as video presentations of award winning properties produced by Dana Morrow



arriving in a smashing maroon dinner jacket. Special Guest Host Ryan Brown, of Bravo TV soon joined Palminteri in handing out awards, noting that he grew up near Santa Barbara and "regularly visits for architectural inspiration!"

First up was Business in Art Award an award originating from the City Arts Advisory Committee. The committee selected **Art From Scrap** as

their fourth annual recipient. The award was presented by Judy Nilsen, Santa Barbara City Arts Advisory Committee and Ginny Brush of the Santa Barbara County Arts Commission. Cay Sanchez of Art From Scrap accepted the award for the program's contributions to educational outreach, recycling and reuse efforts, and the artistic community as a whole. The Business in Art Award is given to an individual or entity that conducts business in the Santa Barbara area and exhibits

outstanding support of arts activity in the community, creating a stronger, more vibrant arts environment in Santa Barbara and enriching the lives of both residents and visitors. A handmade plaque by Dug Uyesaka was presented to commemorate the award.

Next up, Courtney Seeple, President of Santa Barbara Beautiful, presented the President's Award to The Granada Theatre. Peter Frisch, Executive Director of the Granada accepted the award. A video presentation by Road Show Media about the Granada Restoration Project was part of the presentation which honored the theatre for its grand vision that culminated in the restoration of a community treasure. The Granada, a performing arts cultural and entertainment landmark, now celebrates its opening after ten years of making a community dream come true.

The Santa Barbara Center for the Performing Arts spearheaded this restoration project lead by Harriet Miller, president of the board of directors; the individual Board Members; and Peter Frisch, Executive Director.

This world-class performance venue has brought back to life the glamour of the 1924 opening with dazzling detail in dramatically sweeping Spanish staircases, classic Moorish arches, and lavish lounges. The enormous chandelier, long







He has served on the planning commission, the state of California Board of Architectural Examiners; was a Director of the Chamber of Commerce; Chair of the City's Architectural Board of Review for 13 years; served on the Outer State Street Guidelines Committee; the Neighborhood Preservation Ordinance Task Force; the airport improvement task force; and headed up the James Osborne Craig Cross Restoration Project.

He currently chairs the new Santa Barbara Single Family Design Review Board and serves on the Architectural Foundation Board of Directors.

Rounding out his achievements, Mahan is also a skilled watercolorist who paints Santa Barbara's historic buildings, gardens, and paseos.

Virginia Hayes was honored with The Jacaranda Award for Community Service with a plaque presented by Jo Ann Mermis.

Hayes has devoted both her education and career to plants, and remains fascinated by the infinite number of elegant solutions they bring to the challenges of surviving and thriving nearly everywhere on the planet.

Curator of the Living Collection of our beloved local treasure, Ganna Walska Lotusland, Virginia Hayes is an authority on lotus, and has expanded the rich local variety of aquatic flora available. She also presents outreach talks on sustainable gardening throughout California, and her popular gardening column for the Santa Barbara Independent educates the community.

For a second year, Santa Barbara Beautiful bestowed The Plava de Santa Barbara Award for Environmental Stewardship. Presented by Patti Jacquemain to Santa Barbara Wildlife Care Network the award was accepted by Joanne St. John, President for the Network's efforts to rescue, protect, and rehabilitate injured wild birds and native animals along the vast coastline and within the urban forest of Santa Barbara. Assisting wildlife is a way of caring for the beauty and diversity of Santa Barbara.
