Honoring people and projects in our community

SUNLIGHT STREAMED INTO THE GARDEN, as guests and honorees, local representatives, and Board Members arrived for the 46th annual Santa Barbara Beautiful Awards presentation on September 26th.

"Honoring individuals who have improved our community is an important part of beautification," shared Kerry Methner, President, Santa Barbara Beautiful.

Five special awards and ten property awards were part of the evening that began with a pre-awards reception featuring Rebekah Kleinmann Quartet, and savory flavors by Los Arroyos.

After lining up for red-carpet interviews and relaxed conversations, guests adjourned to Hahn Hall where a fast paced awards presentation including a short montage highlighting Santa Barbara Beautiful's (SBB) year round activities in the community headed up the event. The videos featuring the property awards and our beautiful city were produced by **Dana Morrow** of RoadShow Media and narrated by the Hon. **George Eskin** and **Diane Stevenett**.

John Palminteri, Master of Ceremonies, kept the pace quick as various property teams and individual honorees took to the stage to receive recognition.

Kerry Methner, 2010 President of Santa Barbara Beautiful, welcomed guests and thanked the planning team, headed up by **Robert Adams** and the entire SBB Executive team for their efforts throughout the year.

Local dignitaries, including Santa Barbara Mayor **Helene Schneider**, U.S. Congresswoman **Lois Capps**, and City Council Members **Das Williams** and **Frank Hotchkiss** were all in attendance.

This year the Historic Revitalization Award was divided into Commercial and Residential awards. First up was the **Historic Revitalization - Commercial Award** which went to the Santa Barbara Historic Museum for the fabulous renovations completed in the last decade.

Next the **Jacaranda Award** for Community Service was presented to **Marty Blum**, Former Mayor of Santa Barbara. The award was presented by Santa Barbara's current Mayor, **Helene Schneider**.

As the evening continued, individual and property awards were interspersed, with video presentations of each property.

The **Business and Art Award** that originates with the City Arts Advisory Council has found a home at Santa Barbara Beautiful's Annual Awards. The Business in Art Award is

given to an individual or entity that conducts business in the Santa Barbara area and exhibits outstanding support of arts activity in the community, creating a stronger, more vibrant arts environment in Santa Barbara and enriching the lives of both residents and visitors.

The award was presented to **Art Essentials** and **Sam Winkelmeyer**, the sixth annual recipient by **Ginny Brush**, Executive Director of the County Arts Commission. A handmade plaque by **Penny Mast McCall** was presented to commemorate the award.

Other Individual Awards included the Heritage Oak Award for Lifetime Achievement. The honoree, **Phyllis de Picciotto**, received the award from **Robert Adams**.

The **Moreton Bay Fig Award**, was presented to **Barry Berkus** for a body of work and lifetime achievement. While Berkus's work can be seen all

around Santa Barbara, perhaps he is most known for his impact on emerging innovation in the field of residential building. **Dave Davis** presented the award.

For a fourth year, Santa Barbara Beautiful bestowed **The Playa de Santa Barbara Award** for Environmental Stewardship. It was presented by **Dr. Karl Hutterer** to **Peter Howorth** and the SB Marine Mammal Center.

The President's Award went to the Santa Barbara Zoo for their California Trails Exhibit. "They are educating children and adults - and we all remember that the people and places that make childhood special remain with us for the rest of our lives," noted Methner. "The zoo also supports our ecosystem by preserving endangered species." To illustrate the new exhibit, the SB Zoo presented a short video of the exhibit.

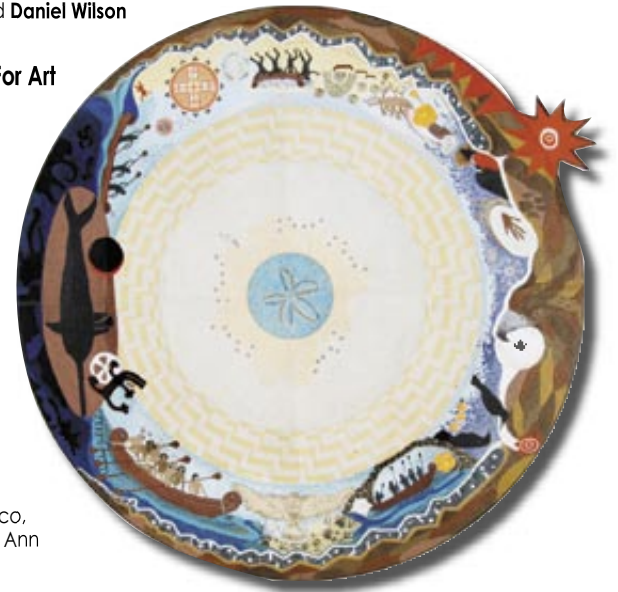
