### 2018 AWARD CATEGORIES - *Please read for New Focus*

#### 1. **Green Home**

What green building elements were included? How does it fit in or enhance the streetscape? Does the project have a \*LEED Certification?

#### 2. **Green Commercial Building**

(Public Buildings, Hotels, B&Bs, Mixed Use): What green built elements were incorporated? How does it contribute to the community? Does this project have a \*LEED Certification?

#### 3. **Public Open Space**

(Parks; Medians; Parkways; Streetscapes): **This year we are looking for the places we gather to heal, build community, and connect with nature.**

#### 4. **Climate Responsive Architectural or Art Feature**

What one feature are you nominating that was done in response to climate change / environmental impacts? IE: Fill in fountain garden; shade structure, memorial; mural; permeable parking elements...

#### 5. **Drought Tolerant, Low Water Use Garden or Landscape**

What elements are incorporated to lower water use? How does this landscape contribute to the streetscape and save water?

- There is no limit to the number of entries a person may submit.
- Winners are selected by independent judges based on merit, not on the number of nominations.

\*LEED: Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design was developed by the non-profit U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) and includes a set of rating systems for the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of green buildings, homes, and neighborhoods that aims to help building owners and operators be environmentally responsible and use resources efficiently.
