2019 AWARD CATEGORIES - *Please read for updated Focus*

1. Santa Barbara Commons: Public Open Space ~

Parks; Medians; Parkways; Streetscapes: places we gather to heal, build community, and connect with nature.

2. Green Single Family Large Lot ~ Lot 1/2 acre & over; What green building elements were included? How does it fit in or enhance the streetscape? Does the project have a *LEED Certification?

3. Green Single Family Small Lot ~ Lot less than 1/2 acre; What green building elements were included? How does it fit in or enhance the streetscape? Does the project have a *LEED Certification?

4. Art in Public Places ~ Murals, Sculpture, etc. (Hugh & Marjorie Petersen Award for Art in Public Places)

5. Green Commercial Building ~ Public Buildings, Hotels, B&Bs, Mixed Use): What green built elements were incorporated? How does it contribute to the community? Does this project have a *LEED Certification?

6. Green Multi-Family Residence ~ Condos, Retirement Facilities; What green building elements were included? How does it fit in or enhance the streetscape? Does the project have a *LEED Certification?

- There is no limit to the number of entries a person may submit.
- Winners are selected by independent judges based on merit, not on the number of nominations.

*LEED: Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design was developed by the non-profit U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) and includes a set of rating systems for the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of green buildings, homes, and neighborhoods that aims to help building owners and operators be environmentally responsible and use resources efficiently.

- *Entries must be visible from the street or via public access.*
- Completed projects within the limits of Ortega Ridge Road to Turnpike Road.
